

Guidance notes

INTRODUCTION

West Kirby Rotary Club announces its third, Small Community Grants Award to assist local organisations.

The award is available to a West Kirby, Hoylake (or neighbouring area) charity, voluntary organisation or worthy cause. Grants cannot be provided to individuals or for salaries and organisations must have an annual income of under £10,000.

Please note the **closing date for applications is 31st May 2026.**

PROCESS

All awards will depend on funding being available, as all Rotary fundraising has been particularly challenging in recent years, and an application form (two pages) must be completed **in full** and fulfil certain criteria. The overall amount awardable is limited and the value of a grant will be determined by West Kirby Rotary Club up to a maximum value of £250.

It is recognised that there are many small volunteering groups whose work enriches the community to whom a small grant could be greatly beneficial. Priority will be given to projects promoted by small groups that involve a number of beneficiaries, or work with vulnerable or disabled children or adults.

Some examples of applications that could be considered; materials for a community art Group, sports equipment for a youth group, a community toddler group requiring a piece of play equipment; support for a one-off community event or funding to support the activities of a support group for refugees. These are purely examples, so please read on to the two-page application, complete and submit it.

West Kirby Rotary Club has a Facebook page and further information may be obtained by sending us a direct message or email via our website.

We wish to make this process as informal as possible but do have to request certain information within the application process. We may also wish to request further information.

It is vital that correct account name or banking details are provided, should you be awarded a grant.

To enable our Club to attract funding from the Public, we undertake to promote how donations are used. Depending on what and how successful grant funds are used, if there are no protection issues involved, we may wish to request a photograph or take one ourselves, reflecting the use of any grants if successful. Please contact us in advance should you have any concerns, as we do not wish to discourage applications.

If children or people with disabilities are involved, we must have written permission of their parents or guardians before any public relations are undertaken, such as photographs.
